




Dear "Pilgrims of Hope"

Other hospitals only give names when patients register as a Catholic and a parishioner of Nativity Duryea (not Holy Rosary, Sacred Heart of Jesus, St. Joseph's, St. Michael's, Peter's and Paul's etc.) Families, PLEASE call the rectory to let father know if a loved one is in the hospital, moved to a nursing home, is homebound, especially if they need a visit for anointing or Eucharist. It is not an inconvenience for Father Michael or the staff or ministers – it is the work of the church to care for those who are sick.
